

Watch for the pyramid-shaped mountain peak - Mount Makana or Bali Hai before rounding the north shore to the renowned Hanalei. Before landing at the Princeville airport, capture some images of the nearly 2-miles (3.2km) of beach favorite ocean activity spot of the Hanalei Bay.



CHECK-IN INFORMATION

Please advise guests and include on your voucher:

 Prompt arrival allows for guest weight check-in, safety briefing, and to be escorted and seated on the aircraft for on-time departure

Līhu'e and Waikoloa tours: Check-in is 1-hour prior to scheduled flight time

Maui, Honolulu, Turtle Bay, Princeville & Hilo tours: Check-in is 45 minutes prior to scheduled flight time

- Late check-in will be considered as a no-show and nonrefundable; traffic is unpredictable in the Islands; please allow for ample travel time in case of traffic delays.
- Please wear dark clothing to minimize reflection in photos. Dress comfortably, as our aircraft are temperature controlled.
- Smartphones are OK; must be in airplane mode. Selfie sticks and extendable wands are not permitted aboard the aircraft.
- Not permitted on aircraft; hats, scarves or bandannas, iPads or tablet computers, purses, bags or camera bags.
- Tour times may vary based upon wind and weather conditions.
- Our chair lifts are only able to access the rear row of seats therefore guests requiring a chair lift to board the helicopter cannot be accommodated in the front row.
- In the event of an emergency front row passengers must be able to receive instructions in English and be physically able to operate exit doors.
- Gratuity not included and left to individual discretion. Credit card option for gratuity after tour is available.



SEATING INFORMATION ...

For the comfort and safety of our guests, please review the below information about seating arrangements on our helicopters:

- Combined front row seat weight must be under 470 lbs and individual passenger weights must be under 240 lbs. Should actual weights during check-in exceed any of these limits guests will be accommodated in other seats and a refund will be made for the premium upgrade fee. If a single guest weighs more than 240 lbs., and wishes to purchase a front row seat, they must also purchase a comfort seat. If the guest is traveling solo, the comfort seat would be the second front seat and would be purchased in addition at full price.
- In the event of an emergency front row passengers must be able to receive instructions in English and be physically capable of operating exit doors.
- All of our bases are wheelchair accessible and ADA compliant, aside from our Turtle Bay location on O'ahu.
 Each base also has a custom built chair lift to assist passengers into the helicopter safely and comfortably. Our chair lifts are able to accommodate passengers up to 250 lbs.
- Chair lifts are only able to access the rear row of seats. Guests requiring a chair lift to board cannot be accommodated in the front row.
- Front row passengers must occupy their own seats and must be able to refrain from interfering with the pilot and instrumentation. Lap children cannot be accommodated in the front row. At least one guest seated in the front row must be 16 years of age.
- Seating arrangements: Unless you charter the complete helicopter you will be sharing the flight with other guests. We try to seat parties traveling together side-by-side as much as possible. We cannot guarantee particular seating as it is often dictated by our FAA approved "weight and balance" program. Each aircraft seats 6 guests. 2: Front Seating and 4: General Seating (refer to the image below).
- If you are particularly prone to motion sickness, taking a precautionary anti-motion sickness medication is a good idea. However, our flights are very smooth and turns are slow and gentle. Most people do not experience motion sickness and do not need an anti-motion sickness medication.





CANCELLATION POLICY

All cancellations must be called into our reservations department by agency.

Any guests who call to cancel their tour directly with us will be redirected to your agency to cancel. No cancellations will be accepted via email.

Tours are non-refundable within cancellation policy as listed:

- For parties of 1-7; 24-hour cancellation Policy
- For parties of 8-17; 72-hour cancellation policy
- For parties of 18+; Group contract with special cancellation
- · A "No-Show" will be fully charged

*For cancellations received within the cancellation policy times listed above, a 100% cancellation fee will be assessed

A doctor's note is required to cancel within the designated cancellation period.

- The doctor's note applies only to the person who holds the note.
- If the person with a doctor's note is a minor, One (1) adult or guardian will be allowed a full refund.
- The doctor's note must be dated within 48 hours of activity date.

WEATHER CANCELLATION

All helicopter tours are subject to weather cancellations. While we make every effort to notify you as soon as possible for changes, the pilot will make a weather call up to 15 minutes prior to flight.
